

**MINUTES OF A COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL  
MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2003 AT 6:30 P.M. IN BUTLER MIDDLE

**General**

Upon motion made by Sheryl Ivey, seconded by Mike Peterson, and passed unanimously it was

RESOLVED, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

**Citizen Review Board.**

**Salt Lake County Mayor's Office**

Jim Braden representing the Salt Lake County Mayor's Office asked the Council to submit its request for funding for 2003, to Kara Trevino.

**Butler Middle School parking lot**

The amended site plan for the Butler Middle School parking lot has been approved. The Jordan School District represented by Steve Wood and Bev Ashby and the Salt Lake County Engineer's Office, represented by Jenna Walker, were present as a courtesy to the council and the neighbors of the school.

Pam Pannier, supported by several neighbors requested that a 4 way stop be installed at the corner of Bridgewater Drive and 2700 East. She gave some history of the accidents at this location and the efforts that went into getting the crossing removed from this location initially.

After a discussion it was recommended that the School District, Butler Middle School Community Council, the Cottonwood Heights Community Council and the citizens join together and request that Salt Lake County conduct a traffic survey of this area.

Upon motion made by Mike Peterson, seconded by Sheryl Ivey and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to write a letter to Salt Lake County requesting that a traffic survey be conducted on 2700 East and the area surrounding Bridgewater Drive. Copies of the letter to be sent to Mayor Workman and Councilman Marv. Hendrickson.

Upon motion made by Mike Peterson, seconded by Ann Bracken, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to make a motion of support to Jordan School District for the parking lot project.

#### **Salt Lake County Engineer's Office**

Jenna Walker, representing Salt Lake County Engineering Department reported on the plans to upgrade the sidewalks on Danish Road and 2700 East. She also reported on the plans to update the intersection of Fort Union and Highland Drive (2000 East).

Upon motion made by Paul Childs, seconded by Sheryl Ivey, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to write a letter to Grover Marsh at Salt Lake County requesting that he attend a meeting of the council to address the proposed plans.

Jenna Walker then reported that some traffic calming devices are scheduled to be installed on several streets including, but not limited to, Prospector, Cavalier, Greenfield, Nantucket, Parkridge and Danish roads.

#### **Billboards**

RESOLVED, to write a letter to Salt Lake County Planning and Zoning asking if the temporary signs installed at 3000 East and 6200 South comply with signage laws and can they now be removed?.
