JUNE 7, 2000 IN BUTLER MIDDLE SCHOOL.**

**General Business**

Joan Carman called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Joan led the pledge of allegiance and a moment of silence.

At this time there were only 3 council members present so all formal business was postponed.

**Director of Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center**

Joan Carman announced the retirement of Richard Guthrie as Director of the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center. She stated that Dick had been the man behind the development of Cottonwood Heights and that the parks and trails would never have been built without him. He is going to be missed in Cottonwood Heights.

She then introduced Mike Peterson, who will replace Dick. She said Mike had some awfully big shoes to fill.

Mike has resided in Cottonwood Heights for the past 25 years and was raised in this area, attending Butler Elementary School. He has 30 years with Salt Lake County, the majority of those in Parks and Recreation.

Carlene explained the district she represents, that she is republican and that she is working very hard to cover the area, discovering what the citizens needs are, prior to the election.

With the advent of the TRAX, some of the regular bus routes were evaluated and some busses eliminated. Some of the citizens were upset because they felt they had been inconvenienced.

The citizens were given the opportunity to voice their concerns and the UTA representatives responded. They also left some literature for any one who wanted to take a copy.

### **Sheriff's Report**

Kent Mackay turned over his time to members of the Community Mobilization Unit. These are members of the community, the sheriff's office and Salt Lake County interested in helping maintain safe neighborhoods. They had started the program by conducting a survey of the citizens and finding that the main areas of concern were car prowls and speeding. They decided to concentrate on car prowls.

Gordon Nicholl reported on the Night out Against Crime, scheduled for August 1, at Bella Vista School. He encouraged everyone to attend.
