

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS  
COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD JANUARY 28, 2003 IN THE COTTONWOOD  
HEIGHTS RECREATION CENTER AT 7 P.M.**

Gordon Nicholl called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

In response to the agenda of a February 4<sup>th</sup> 2003 public hearing by Salt Lake County Council, for the purpose of establishing the township of Cottonwood Heights, the Cottonwood Heights Community Council is meeting in special session.

This meeting was duly advertised in compliance with the open meeting law. One member of the general public was in attendance.

Paul Childs presented a "draft" letter to the Salt Lake County Council, outlining the Cottonwood Heights Community Council's objection to the formation of a township. Each member present reviewed this letter and a discussion ensued.

Upon motion made by Paul Childs, seconded by Ann Bracken and passed unanimously it was

RESOLVED, to re-work the letter, re-circulate it to all the Cottonwood Heights Community Council members, giving them the opportunity to respond. Authority was given to Gordon Nicholl to sign the final letter on behalf of all the members. The letter will then be sent to each member of the Salt Lake County Council personally, prior to the February 4<sup>th</sup> meeting.
