June Police Report

Police Support Specialist Sheila Jennings presented statistics for the month of June. She noted that the office is short staffed due to officers using their time off before the year end. Overall, calls for service were up with an increase in priority 3 and 4 calls due to summer activities. The response time for priority 1 calls averaged less than 4.5 minutes and priority 3 calls averaged less than 8 minutes.

Ms. Jennings reported that arrests were up slightly, but that traffic citations and DUI's decreased due to the shortage of staff.

Public Works Director Mike Allen presented the public works report for the month of June. He reported that the Union Park Median Landscape Project is now underway; the storm drain mapping project is progressing; and the completion of the 7200 South Safe Sidewalks to School Project has been delayed while a sump box is designed.

The Big Cottonwood Canyon Trail ribbon-cutting ceremony is scheduled for July 16 and the contractor is working to complete the grading issues and cleanup.
