

MINUTES OF A COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

GENERAL BUSINESS

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Gordon Thomas.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given by Steve Knudson.

Upon motion made by Cameron Hansen, seconded by Verl Buxton, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

Because of a misunderstanding regarding the time of the meeting the agenda was amended to postpone Mr. Rasmussen until 7:00 p.m.

COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS RECREATION CENTER

Richard Guthrie, representing the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center, presented a proposal for facility expansion and park improvement through a bond election.

The improvements would include an adaptive aquatics center, a gymnasium, improved locker rooms, fitness room, senior citizen center, meeting rooms, and the upgrading of school grounds to make community parks.

The Council thanked Mr. Guthrie for his presentation, and commended him for making the Cottonwood Heights area a better place to live through his position as Director of the Recreation Center.

Upon motion made by Steve Knudson, seconded by Nick Morgan and approved unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to approve the proposal to expand and improve the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center facilities and to support the bond election.

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

Gordon Thomas reviewed the conditional use permit and reinforced that the Council can recommend any restrictions they feel are necessary.

COMMUNITY COUNCIL BOUNDARIES
