RESOLVED, to approve this application with the following conditions.

The Council will approve the trailer remaining on site for one more year if

1. A gate is put on the bottom of the ramp to deter skateboarders and
 2. A rubber mat is installed at the bottom of the ramp to cut down on noise within the next 60 days.
 3. The trailer and parking lot are supervised during open hours
- This will be reviewed in one year.
