

# **Minutes of a Cottonwood Heights Community Council Meeting Held December 2, 1998 at 6:30 in Butler Middle School**

Council members present and excused listed at the end of the minutes.

## **Last Meeting's Minutes**

Motion to approve by Gregg. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl. Passed unanimously.

## **Crime Report, Bill Morris**

Working on playground violence, with Mrs. Utah. Also "Not this Kid" program. Sheriff has website, where statistics and maps are being posted. Crime stats reviewed. Sex offenses have gone up considerably this month. Some problems occurred with children at schools. SL County has 1.3 officers per 1000 people.

## **ACCT Report, Joyce Smith**

Highlights of last ACCT meeting: SL County and SL City are working to consolidate recreation, annexation, wall-to-wall cities, consolidation of municipal services. Next meeting December 10, 1998, 11:00, 4<sup>th</sup> floor.

## **General**

Motion to have Joyce as one of our representatives for ACCT, even though she won't be on the council. Motion by Bill. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl. Passed unanimously.

Motion by Bill for Karen to write a letter to the County Commissioners that Kara Trevino has done a great job and should not be terminated. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joyce. For (Brett, Good, Carl, Joyce, Bill), Abstain because he doesn't know Kara and not sure we should get involved in personnel decisions at the county (Gregg): Motion passed.

Motion by Carl for Margaret get a commemorative plaque for Karen "in appreciation". 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill. Passed unanimously.

Motion by Carl for Margaret get a commemorative place for Joyce "in appreciation". 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill. Passed. Joyce abstained for obvious reasons.

## **Issues**

There will be vote in February to determine if Holladay will be a city. However, legislative issues are being developed that would block that incorporation. Current legislation says that incorporated cities can have significant budget surpluses.

Steve Poulton agreed to carry a bill that would require power lines to be buried. Utah Power against this.

Bella Vista school is not being considered for a change in its mission or student base.

An assisted living facility is proposed for 2000 East, just south of Fort Union.

Motion by Bill for Karen to write a letter to the LDS Church that parking is welcome at the Whitmore Library ONLY when the library is closed. Members of the church should park in the church parking lot first. Once filled, over-flow is allowed in library when its closed. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joyce. Passed unanimously.

House on 1300 East and Hollowdale Drive (approx. 6800 South) has a dumpster outside that is rarely emptied. Recently a couch sat on the top (pictures provided) for several weeks. For the past couple weeks a mattress has been leaning against the dumpster. This is a residential neighborhood. Motion by Bill for Gregg to write a letter to Health Dept directed to Mike Dinoso, and Gregg is allowed to represent the council on this matter. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl. Passed unanimously.

## **Zoning**

Fire Station on Wasatch Blvd: funding has been withdrawn from the budget, so this won't be considered at this meeting.

PL13882 – Rezone from C1 to R-2-8. High-end condominium project to be built here. Motion by Joyce to approve. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill. Passed unanimously.

PL 13558 – Rezone from C1 to C2. Motion by Gregg to continue this item. Did not pass. Motion by Gregg to deny application. Did not pass. Motion by Joyce to deny requested application, but note on the denial that the Community Council would approve of a C1 to MD-3 rezone. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carl. For (Carl, Brett, Good), Against because the council is ill-informed of what a MD-3 rezone is (Gregg), Abstain because the county recommended a C2 (Bill): Motion passed.

## **Meeting Adjourn**

Motion by Gregg to end the meeting. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill. Passed unanimously.
