

**MINUTES OF A COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL
MEETING HELD MAY 2, 2001 AT 6:30 P.M. IN BUTLER MIDDLE SCHOOL**

General

Gordon Nicholl called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Upon motion made by Bill Morris, seconded by Pat Warner, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

ACCT Report

Jerri Harwell reported on the meeting held April 12th.

The sheriff's department has requested that the council identify the top 3 issues the council would like to see addressed.

A commendation was issued to Deputy Scott Hansen for his contribution to the Community Councils and Neighborhood Watch.

ACCT would like to have the councils compare their boundaries with the ones issued by the State.

The council will send a letter to the Salt Lake County Mayor asking for a legal description of the Cottonwood Heights Community Council boundaries.

Sheriff's Report

Deputy Scott Hansen gave the crime statistics for April 2001. He again recommended that all neighborhoods get involved in the neighborhood watch program and that the Boy Scouts take their crime prevention badge.

Deputy Hansen was asked if he would check in to the parking on Big Cottonwood Canyon Rd, outside the Hog Wallow restaurant.

Representative Patrice Arent addressed the Council and explained the plans for holding the legislative sessions during the Olympics and also what was happening at this time. She encouraged the citizens to keep in touch by phone or e-mail.

#19456 Telecommunication Facility at 7137 South 2700 East

Glen Nelson explained that this facility would be on an existing U P and L Pole. After discussion and upon motion made by Ann Bracken, seconded by Sheryl Ivey, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to deny this request and recommend that Qwest approach Butler Elementary school and maybe use a flagpole or erect a facility on the top of the school.

Incorporation

Paul Childs had prepared a handout for the council and the citizens. He explained the process for incorporating.

Upon motion made by Mike Peterson, seconded by Pat Warner, and passed unanimously,
it was

RESOLVED, to nominate Kip Lindsay as chairperson of a committee to pursue the incorporation of the Cottonwood Heights Area. Ann Bracken, Pat Warner, and Bill Morris will serve on the committee and will also ask as liaison with the council.

Widening of Danish Road

There will a meeting with Salt Lake County on May 17th at 6 p.m. in Butler Middle School. All interested parties are invited to attend.

Brighton Point Shopping Center.

Tom Cook of Collier, representing Amoco Corporation, wanted feedback from the Council on the use of a piece of property on the North East corner of the Smith's parking lot, at 3500 East Bengal Boulevard.

Smith's Food King is interested in purchasing it and putting in a fuel stop. This would not include a convenience store or car wash.

Mr. Cook wanted to know if it was worth pursuing.

The Council said they would listen to all applications.

Other Business

Mr. Robert Kolan of Cavalier Drive asked the Council what he could do to reduce speed on Cavalier Drive, a through street from 2300 East to 2700 East.

Upon motion made by Mike Peterson, and seconded by Pat Warner, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to have the Council write a letter to Salt Lake County Public Works asking for help in this.

Mr. Kolan was also given some names to call.

Another item of concern was the wall on the South side of Fort Union Boulevard, from 2700 East to Promenade Drive. This wall has many protrusions, which are dangerous.

Upon motion made by Mike Peterson, and seconded by Pat Warner, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to have the Council write a letter to Salt Lake County Public Works asking for help in this.
