

**MINUTES OF A COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL
MEETING HELD JUNE 4, 2003 IN BUTLER MIDDLE SCHOOL, 7520 SOUTH
2700 EAST, SALT LAKE CITY, AT 6:30 P.M.**

General Business:

Sheriff's Report

Detective Scott Hansen presented the crime figures for May 2003. He told the citizens to be cautious of allowing people into their homes or garages – e.g. maintenance people as theft is becoming more commonplace.

Fire Department Report

Road Issue

On June 11th at 9 a.m. Cottonwood Heights Township Planning and Zoning board will meet in the Council Chamber, 2001 South State Street to discuss two issues regarding the road at the mouth of Big Cottonwood canyon. The two issues to be discussed will be

1. Does the road meet the County grade?
2. Does the radius of the turns meet county standards?

Salt Lake County Mayor's Office

Jim Braden reported for the Mayor's office on the Fire Department, which services 330,000 citizens with 270 firefighters. 75% of the calls are medical related. Salt Lake County is trying to contract with Gold Cross. He also reported on the aging stations in Holladay and East Millcreek.

Firework restrictions are in place on areas above Wasatch Boulevard, West of the U111, and South of Bangerter.

Highland Drive/Fort Union Intersection

Grover Marsh of Salt Lake County reviewed the plans to upgrade the intersection at Highland Drive and Fort Union. The work will be advertised in August 2003 and work will be completed within the following year.

After reviewing these plans and the traffic survey the Council was very pleased and felt it would be a great improvement.

Due to the construction in Butler Middle School parking lot no meeting space will be available at the school or the recreation center. Gordon to check with the elementary schools for availability.
