1. The relocation of Fire Station 16 to Wasatch Boulevard and the imminent use of the old fire station by the Sheriff's Department. Presently scheduled for October 1, 2001
2. The intent by Salt Lake City to annex the unincorporated East side of Salt Lake County in the event the areas fail to incorporate.
3. Lobbyists for Salt Lake County are needed – Contact Sheryl Ivey or Paulina Flint.

Danish Road

Salt Lake County has released plans to widen Danish Rd. The road will be 43' wide. There will be a sidewalk on one side, bicycle trail on one side, speed humps and four traffic circles to slow traffic. No large trucks will be allowed on Danish Rd.
