 density too great

 access to Prospector Drive too close to spur
 roads are too narrow
 would Wasatch be widened to accommodate ski rentals?
 some of the homes were grandfathered in after they were used
 as ski rentals prior to 1991.
 citizens felt that the planning commission were undermining
 the Council by changing the Master Plan
 citizens complained that the Planning Commission were not
 returning ot taking their calls
 will the zoning go any higher than R-2-8?
 keep the land aesthetically pleasing towards the canyons
 liability - PUD would be right on the fault
 Honeywood duplexes - were they grandfathered in?
