

**MINUTES OF A COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
HELD DECEMBER 6, 1995 AT 6:30 P.M. IN BUTLER MIDDLE SCHOOL.**

General

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Karen Eyre.
The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given by Troop 822.

Upon motion made by Cameron Hansen, seconded by Brian Smith, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

Salt Lake County Recreation

Kay Cameron representing Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation gave a 10 minute review and slide show updating the residents of Cottonwood Heights on the programs offered by Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation in the Cottonwood Heights area and letting them know that there is now an office inside the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center where people can register for programs and receive information. This is supplemental to the programs offered through the Recreation Center.

Karen Eyre thanked Kay Cameron for the presentation.

Incorporation

David Muir gave an update on incorporation and indicated that he would be outside the meeting in the school hallway to take signatures from any interested parties.

Zoning

PL-95-4086 2126 East 7000 South

After discussion and upon motion made by Joyce Smith, seconded by Cameron Hansen, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to table this decision until more information is available regarding the business license of the karate program and until all members of the Council get a chance to drive the private road leading to the business.

PL-95-4084 Medium Density Residential Zones

Upon motion made by Cameron Hansen, seconded by Nick Morgan, and passed unanimously it was

RESOLVED, to recommend approval of this text change.

PL-95-4090 Definition of Hotel

Upon motion made by Cameron Hansen, seconded by Nick Morgan, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to not recommend approval of this request for a text change because of insufficient information.

PL-95-4091 Residential Health Care Facilities

Upon motion made by Cameron Hansen, seconded by Nick Morgan, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to not recommend approval of this request for a text change.

U.A.C.C. Report

Joyce Smith gave a report of the last U.A.C.C. meeting held. Discussed were the jail situation, the reorganization and financial situation of U.A.C.C., and the blight.

6600 South

Karen Eyre reported that so far nothing had been done on the request to reopen 6600 South into the Mill Hollow subdivision.

Hollow Mill Drive

Regarding the speed on Hollow Mill Drive, this problem was referred to Tosh Kano but so far no speed checks have been done on Hollow Mill Drive. The indication from Mike Witterson was that these would be conducted if the weather cooperated.

Fort Union Boulevard

Fort Union from Promenade Drive to Wasatch Boulevard is scheduled for widening to 5 lanes. Design will be completed in the next 6 months with the work to be completed in 1997/98.

Audit

Salt Lake County Auditors will be conducting an audit of the financial records of the Community Council.

Scout A Rama

No decision has been received from Salt Lake County regarding the placement of banners for the Boy Scouts Scoutarama.

Council Boundaries

Response to a letter to the County Commissioners requesting a review of the Council boundaries. The County thinks that it is premature to review them whilst the incorporation of The Cottonwoods is on file. If both Councils agree on the changes then the County would consider the request.

Butler Middle School Recognition of Staff

Upon motion made by Richard Guthrie, seconded by Cameron Hansen, and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to authorize Rand Call, the Council Treasurer, to spend up to \$50 for gifts to give to the janitorial staff, the office staff and the choral teacher, Mrs Jorgensen, of Butler Middle school in recognition of the Council's use of their property and their cooperation with the Council.

Mill Hollow Park and Old Mill Trails

Richard Guthrie reported that in the 1996 Budget Hearing for Salt Lake County Recreation \$250,000 had been allocated towards the development of Mill Hollow Park and \$70,000 for the development of trails in the Old Mill area.

Salt Lake County Fire Dept. and Sheriff's

Verl Buxton reported that a start had been made on the fire station on Fort Union Boulevard at approximately 1800 East. This will replace the 6500 South 1300 East Fire Station. Verl Buxton expressed concern on the speed with which the Sheriff's department was responding to calls in the Cottonwood Heights area.

Upon motion made by Cameron Hansen, seconded by Nick Morgan and passed unanimously, it was

RESOLVED, to send a letter to the Sheriff's Department requesting that a representative of the Sheriff's Department be designated to attend the Council's January meeting.

Wetland Project

Brett Besser reported that he had applied for more funding for the Wetlands Project in the amount of \$1,200.
